Position Title: Rework Mechanic

### Basic Function:

The primary responsibility of this role is to work on a metallizer with additional responsibilities to perform preparation and detailed restoration of engine parts & components. Conforming to the specific routing tag & engine manual instructions of model being worked using approved data.

### Duties are as follows but not limited to:

- Preparation, rework and masking of various engine parts. Application of surface treatments and coatings.
- Clean, set up and operate metallizer per scheduled sequence, work instructions and customer requirement.
- Ensures the use of appropriate manual references and proper tools in performing component restoration.
- Knowledgeable and responsible for the cleaning and maintenance of all supporting equipment in the depart.
- Removes grease, dirt, paint, and corrosion from aircraft surface, using media equipment, abrasives, solvents, and brushes.
- Perform heat treatment and stress relief process.

### Requirements:
